Background

Children with ADHD often show significant behavioral, social, and academic impairments before kindergarten. While behavioral parent training (BPT) is the recommended first-line treatment for young children with ADHD, access and participation are limited due to cost, clinician availability, scheduling barriers, and stigma. As a result, most families don't receive these critical services.

Tech Overview

Developed by researchers at Lehigh University, PEAK is a structured, 10-session BPT program delivered either face-to-face (F2F) or asynchronously online. It provides parents of preschoolers with ADHD with practical strategies to manage behavior, improve self-regulation, and be more optimistic about parenting.

The scalable online format dramatically increases access without sacrificing effectiveness, offering flexibility and convenience for families.

- Improves Child Outcomes Reduces ADHD symptoms, oppositional behaviors, and improves selfregulation in preschool-aged children.
- High Parent Engagement Achieves ~80% session completion, exceeding typical behavioral parent training benchmarks.
